STATEMENT ON THE DEBT CEILING DEAL BY HON. DAVID M. WALKER, FOUNDER AND CEO OF THE COMEBACK AMERICA INITIATIVE, AND FORMER U.S. COMPTROLLER GENERAL

August 2, 2011

David Walker, Founder and CEO of the Comeback America Initiative and former Comptroller General of the United States, issued the following statement today on the debt ceiling deal.

"The President and the Congress should be congratulated on achieving an agreement that will avert default. However, the related process took far too long and the resulting deal is a very modest first step on what will be a long and difficult road to restore fiscal sanity.

The deal may not be enough to avert a downgrade of U.S. debt. Only time will tell. It is now critically important that Congressional leaders appoint capable and credible members to the special Joint Committee. These Members must be willing to engage in constructive compromise for the good of the country. They should also seek to achieve much more than the targeted \$1.5 trillion in deficit reduction over 10 years. After all, the U.S. is in an over \$60 trillion financial hole that grows by several trillion dollars a year based on our current path.

It is also critically important that the President and the Congress work together to create and support a meaningful citizen education and engagement effort that will extend beyond Washington's Beltway. The American people must be given the facts and be provided with the specific types of tough entitlement, defense, other spending, and tax reforms that needed to ensure both a strong and sustainable economy and a healthy employment environment for today and the future. Inside the Beltway solutions will not be successful and sustainable over time."
